We create a safe environment where you can share your own unique connection or disconnection including any pain or wounding suffered from the misuse or distortions of Christianity. The retreat will focus on experiential inner work within the safety of a group container. Our group modalities include Pathwork emotional process work, "process meditation," movement explorations, sacred ritual, personal sharing and conceptual discussion.

Darlene Rollins is a Pathwork Helper on this path since 1984. She is especially pleased to offer this integration of the transformative characterological work of the Pathwork with its cosmological foundations which takes her work to a transpersonal and soul level.
